Formula One Racing

Are you a motorcar racing fan? Read on to know more about the sport.

Formula One is an exciting sport for motorcar racing fans. The best drivers in the world compete in high-speed races on the world's greatest circuits. Usually, twenty-two drivers participate in the World Championships that consist of nineteen races through the year. Each race is held in a different country.

Each team has two drivers. At the end of the year, the team with the highest number of points wins the Constructors' Championship. The driver who wins each race gets 25 points. The driver with the most points at the end of the season wins the Drivers' Championship. A driver's success depends on how the designers and mechanics prepare his car before the race, how well his team takes care of the car during the race and how well he drives.

A Formula 1 race track has fast and slow corners to test how the drivers can handle their cars while taking turns. There are also straight lanes where the drivers can drive the vehicle as fast as possible. A Formula 1 car is a light, single-seater vehicle. It costs a lot of money to build and take care of these cars. The racing teams collect this money from sponsors.

The body of the car is covered with the names and logos of the sponsors. It is a dangerous sport and drivers often meet with accidents. They have to protect themselves by wearing a helmet and other protective clothing. Under their racing suits they wear fire proof clothing. Lewis Hamilton of Great Britain, and Michael Schumacher and Sebastian Vettel of Germany have been the most successful drivers in recent years. They are very rich and famous and have thousands of fans around the world.
